Along with its regular activities, Sports Department is organising many events to promote and flourish Sports coaching in and around Delhi area. Following is the brief report of the activities and programmes conducted in the Sports Department from 01st July till 15th August 2023.

The Department of Sports organised the Final Test and the Valedictory of the Lifeguard and Instructor Renewal Course. Final Test was conducted on 28th July 2023 by Mr. Joseph Kuok International Swimmer) and Mr. Satish Chander (NIS recognised Trainer). Total number of 21 candidates underwent Lifeguard and Instructors' Renewal Course. All the successful candidates were awarded with Certificate. Lifeguard Course Instructor Training was also conducted by New Delhi YMCA, in which 29 candidates completed the course successfully and were awarded with Certificates. The Course Director for this was Mr. Rajkumar (Renowned Swimming Coach).

New Delhi YMCA, Department of Sports has been conducting regular coaching in Lawn Tennis, Basketball, Volleyball, Karate and Swimming. It is also running a Fitness Center with good facilities. We have the best of Coaches and Instructors for training in the Sports. All the activities are running with a good number of Members in different batches. We have very good participation from our members, who are showcasing their enthusiasm for sports and fitness throughout the year.

1.Swimming Pool: Swimming Coaching is provided for the beginners and Practice for the swimmers. Swimming Pool is open in the morning from 6:00 am till 10:00 am and again in the evening from 3:00 pm till 9:00 pm. A total of 5 Coaches and Lifeguards (Male and Female) give coaching to all the enrolled members.

The total number of Members registered for Swimming Practice was 62, For Swimming Coaching it was 488 and for Toddlers it was 24 Members from 1st July to 15th August 2023.



Volleyball coaching is being provided to the members in the evening from Monday to Friday by professional Coaches. In Volleyball activity the number of members is gradually increasing.

For Basketball, Coaching, classes are conducted in the evening on alternate days. Total participation for Basketball coaching was 33 members from 1st July to 15th August 2023.

The Lawn Tennis coaching is being conducted both in the morning as well as in the evening. 45 members registered during 1st July to 15th August 2023 for Lawn Tennis coaching and practice.







YMCA Fitness Center facilities are well-utilized. We have two well-trained Gym Instructors, who spend time with the members and guide them to achieve in their Fitness goals. 105 Members were registered for Fitness Center during 1st July to 15th August 2023.



36 Members were registered in the period of 1st July to 15th August 2023 for Karate classes. Karate coaching is being provided to the members in the evening hours thrice a week by professional Trainers.



Greater Noida Programme Centre

Greater Noida Programme Centre is a well-known and most sought-after property for recreational purposes in the Greater Noida GNPC focuses primarily on the needs, goals, and desires of young people. Over the years, people from all walks of life, irrespective of Cast, Creed and Gender, have been getting the opportunity to avail facilities in various sports activities.

The GNPC is conveniently situated, covering six acres of land with breathtaking atmosphere. GNPC is a multi-purpose recreational facility that serves the needs of different people, families, organisations, and business entities. Elders love to throng the GNPC campus and engage in leisure activities, spend time in the restaurant, take a walk, sit on benches under the tree shade and love to breathe in the overall ambient green environs of the premises, while they watch or wait for their loved ones who meanwhile indulge in their respective activities.

GNPC offers following Sports & Recreational activities.

Baskethall

We have a newly renovated Basketball court with a modern synthetic surface of International standards. We are getting good response in terms of new registrations since the new basketball court has been laid. The month of July 11 students registered for basketball coaching.

Cricket:

A lush green top sports field is being used for Cricket. Our Cricket coaching programme in July 2023 recorded a membership of 32 students. They enjoy the environment and the surroundings with a professional coach. We are in the process of improving facilities for Cricket coaching, so that we are able to provide the best quality infra-structure to our programme participants.

Fitness Centre:

We at GNPC have a state-of-the-art indoor Gym facility with professional coach/fitness instructor. As per the usual demand, Gym attracted an impressive number of members from in and around Greater Noida. The total number of gym memberships for the period stood at 105 members. The air conditioned modern gymnasium with the best equipment and machines has been the main attraction for the residents in the area. We have been getting some overwhelming response for our fitness centre and people really enjoy coming and availing the facilities which are well maintained.

Karate:

We also have a Karate training programme and we to organise competitions from time to time to encourage the students to regularly attend the sessions and learn self-defense techniques. The total number of students in the month of July was 39.

Lawn Tennis

Another major attraction of the GNPC property among outdoor sports is the Lawn Tennis facility. It boasts of an International standard turf that is used for coaching as well as recreational purposes. In terms of memberships we had 34 enthusiasts for Tennis coaching in July 2023.

Swimming Pool:

Another feather in our cap is the Olympic size Swimming pool. We hold regular coaching programmes for beginners and swimming practice sessions for professionals as well. The swimming pool is open from April to September every year wherein 537 members enjoyed our facility in the July 2023 time period.

Auditorium:

GNPC also has an Auditorium, which is fully air-conditioned and has a seating capacity of 150 people. Various Programmes / Conferences / Seminars and Workshops are organised in this facility.

Restaurant:

The GNPC features a large Restaurant with a seating capacity for 100 people. The restaurant has a multi-cuisine menu and offers both A la Carte and Buffet options.

Guest Rooms / Accommodation: GNPC offers 24 air conditioned rooms Our accommodations is available for our Members on a single, double, or triple occupancy basis, depending on their needs.
