**Subject: Fixed Schedule for Renewal of Annual Membership December- January**

Dear Members,

Greetings!

It has been observed that sometimes renewal of Membership by members inadvertently gets delayed, crosses the expiry date, and sometimes even the 90 days grace period from the date of expiry of the membership as provided in the Memorandum of the Association exceeds.

To make the process easier, the Board of Directors vide resolution in its meeting (BOD -403) held on 3rd March 2022 decided; "All annual membership renewals to take place in December and January. Now onwards wef 1st May 2022, the annual subscription Rs.500/- to be charged proportionately @ Rs 41.67 per month for the remaining months to follow till 31st January 2023." Therefore, w.e.f. 1st May 2022, Membership renewal subscription will be charged @ Rs.41.67 per month up till January 31st, 2023.

For instance, if renewal is due in May 2022, the subscription will be charged for 09 months upto 31st January 2023 @ Rs.41.67 per month i.e Rs.375.03. Thereafter, from 1 February 2023 onwards annual subscription of Rs.500/- will continue with validity till 31 January 2024.

This will ease the things for members to remember the renewal date i.e in the month of January every year. Members may pay the subscription and renew their membership every year from December- to January.

Mr. Ramakrishnan, a music lover who initiated Jazz programs in Delhi, was also hooked to the Easter Pipe Organ Concert.

"You won't believe it, she started singing prayers she used to sing in her school days in Trivandrum, in the 1930s" said Mr. Ramakrishnan, a Malayali Brahmin. Our early education was in convent schools," Mr. Ramakrishnan added. The Free Orthopedics Camp was organized in association with Dr. Khera's Wellness Clinic & Apollo Spectra Hospitals. The Program began with an Opening Prayer by Mr. Noel Phillips, Associate General Secretary, who prayed for the gathering and the success of the Initiative. Mr. Mark Clive, General Secretary & CEO, shared his valuable greetings and good wishes along with some insightful thoughts and expressed his appreciation for the conceptualization of the Program. To Support Parental Care for the children of the working parents in the community and also to focus on the Early Childhood Development of children in the age group of 1 to 5 yrs the CDCs at Kalyanpuri, Karpoori Thakur, and Savda Ghevra started with the Day Care Centre activity every day from 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Proper and Standardised Activity schedule is followed throughout the day. A regular Diet chart is followed with a special diet for Under Weight and Malnourished children. A regular health record is maintained with the Height & Weight of each Child. At present, there are 57 children enrolled with the Day Care Centre. A meeting was organized with the Parents of the children on 20th April 2022 at CDC Savda Ghevra. The main objective of the meeting was to share information and discuss the daily routine and procedures to be followed in Day Care Centers. Also discussed are the safety measures to be followed. The session was taken by Ms. Anjali Choudhary, Counselor & Mr. Gulab Chand field Supervisor CDC Savda Ghevra.

Microsoft Office (CCMO) from CDCs Savda Ghevra and Daya Basti. Completion Certificates were distributed to the students on 16th & 19th April 2022 respectively. Along with Certificate Distribution, a session was organized to discuss various career options and job opportunities after successfully acquiring the Certificates.
