Dear members, Greetings!

At the outset, I thank your all for your valuable participation in AGM 2022 and unanimously adopting the Annual Report along with the audited Statement of Accounts 2021-22. New Delhi YMCA moves on with its Mission & Business which is evident from number of programmes organized in 2021-22, and so far in 2022-23 as being reported through Newsletters. NDY's revenue generation activities too, are doing exceedingly well.

It is a matter of pride that in 2022, Education Centre and Y Nizamuddin Centre are celebrating 50 years of their existence. Both were established in 1972, Education Centre at Jai Singh Road to impart management education, skill training and coaching for Government entrance exams & tests, and Nizamuddin Centre as a family centre for recreational activities for residents of Nizamuddin and other colonies around South Delhi. Today, the Education Centre is housing Human Potential Development Programmes conducting undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in 72 disciplines. In normal conditions, around 2000 young people join the YMCA to equip themselves for the competitive world of today. Nizamuddin Centre is now YMCA Public School affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education with all three disciplines. Besides this, YPS runs on an integrated education format to take care of the special educational needs of the disabled. A diploma program in special education recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of the Government of India is yet another sort-after programme. Both Education Centre and Nizamuddin Centre have grown over the years.

Now, New Delhi YMCA plans to revisit the needs of the Rural Community, Hodal in Haryana. YMCA Public School is already functional up to class VI. To address changing needs of the rural community and the context of the setting of Hodal town, New Delhi YMCA is planning to develop Hodal Centre into a hub of Education, Skill Training and Sports coaching centre.

To celebrate 50 years of Education Centre and Nizamuddin Centre, the New Delhi YMCA has planned a Carnival scheduled for 4th December 2022. Besides, a cultural extravaganza the CARNIVAL shall be a fundraiser.

It is a benign request to all members to join and collectively as one unit make the event a successful initiative to raise funds and support the good cause of empowering the rural community and the girl child in particular. Funds raised from the Carnival will be utilized for the development of Hodal infrastructure for School, sports coaching and skill training. Attached please find a detailed brochure giving details with objectives and ways a member can contribute.

The theme of the carnival is 'Beti Padhao Beti Bacha.'

In the end, I am pleased to inform the membership that both the Mission and Business activities of New Delhi YMCA are doing well and leaving behind the damage done by the Pandemic in the past two years.

The objective of the program was to reduce infant and childhood mortality and morbidity and to promote child care and physical and psychosocial development within the family. The resource person was Ms. Leena Kumari ANM (Auxiliary Nurse & Midwife) from Delhi Government Dispensary Savda Ghevra. 26 parents participated in the programme.

Another AGP was organized on the same issue at CDC Karpoori Thakur on 24th September 2022 with the parents of Day Care and Balwadi classes. The parents were made aware of the low-cost Nutrition Diet / Food for Good Health and also the importance of Immunization. The Resource Person was Ms. Rajvinder Kaur, from Can Support NGO. 26 parents participated in the programme.

The Awareness Session on Yoga & Meditation was organized on 21st September 2022 at CDC Kalyanpuri.
