May God bless us all.



Report: 23rd, April to 24th, May 2021

Regular Programme

For the month of April 2021, 502 Students attended regular activities Basic Computer Course, NIIT CCMO Computer Course, Diploma in Cutting and Tailoring, Remedial Education, Coaching and Mehndi at all Five Community Development Centres.

Awareness Generation Programmes (AGP) and Workshops

The Department of Social and Human Development organised awareness Generation Programme for the community Children / Women / Adolescent Girls in various need base issues. Like - Reproductive Health and Family Planning, and Empowerment, Women Safety Water Issues, Menstruation and Use of Sanitary Napkins, Covid-19, Gender Sensitive, Career Guidance, Health and hygiene at all Five Community Development Centres (Sunlight Colony, Kalyanpuri, Karpoori Thakur, Daya Basti and Savda Ghevra), all these programmes organised with the help of NGO's expert (Magic Bus Foundation, Pariwar Sewa Sangstha, etc.) and Y SHD Staffs itself. Main Objective of all these programmes was to create awareness and prevent from all these, around 375+ beneficiaries attended these programmes.

New Delhi YMCA, HPDP

In the current academic year, the HPDP sector has 367 admissions in its various courses. 23 companies have registered with our Placement Department and till date 72 students have taken part in interviews conducted by 11 companies.

Approximately, 266 students have taken part in examination conducted successfully by our Examination Department.

YMCA Public School
