The New Delhi YMCA since its inception has always responded to the various needs of the community, through programmes of support, both economic and education for empowerment and development.

The New Delhi YMCA founded in 1927, has established its credentials as a dynamic youth centric, service oriented movement in the city of Delhi. The organisational structure reflects commitment to YMCA values, best practices in management and above all agility to change with time to stay relevant. The organisation strives for human empowerment, harmony and high ethical standards.

New Delhi YMCA is running Social and Human Development (SHD), a Project to reach the underprivileged section of the Society. This Project started in 1987 to cater the needs of the community.

The Mission of New Delhi YMCA is to assist, guide and empower it's Members and staff to accomplish the aims and objectives of the YMCA as enshrined in its Memorandum and Articles of Association (Constitution), to ensure continuing relevance and to help build a better Delhi, emphasising the members' commitment to 'Serve and Not To Be Served'.

The Department of Social and Human Development works with the underprivileged and the urban poor living in Delhi's different clusters and resettlement colonies. As part of our commitment to community development we have been organising programmes and activities. Developing self-reliant society by educating and motivating the urban poor, concentrating on Child care, Community health care, Education, Vocational and Skill development activities and Women empowerment programmes. The Community work is coordinated through five Community Development Centres (CDC) at **Sunlight Colony** in North East Delhi, **Karpoori Thakur** in South Delhi, **Daya Basti** in North Delhi, **Savda-Ghevra** in North-West Delhi and **Kalyanpuri** in East Delhi. These Community Development Centres run their activities through **29 Alternative Learning Centres** (ALC) which are the sub centres around the main centre in radius of 1 to 3 kilometres.

SHD Project is working mainly for the people in three categories. Firstly the children from 0 to 6 years of age. We provide **Child Care** (Crèche) and **Balwadi** facilities to 900 children.

Next category is of the children from 7 to 16 years of age. We provide **Remedial classes** and **Coaching classes** to support 1,500 children in their Formal education.

In the third category, We provide **Skill development** and training for 300 youth who have completed class X, XII and Graduation level.

YMCA also provides Mid-Day-Meal to these children and also organises Sports and Cultural activities for the wholesome development of these children. We in YMCA work for the development of Body, Mind and Spirit of an individual for wholesome development.

New Delhi YMCA is serving the community through its activities since last 95 years. But at this difficult time, YMCA is facing huge financial crunch and finding it difficult to serve the Beneficiaries through regular activities and services. YMCA does not want to discontinue with this noble cause. That is why we seek support from our Well - wishers to sponsor at least one child to continue with studies and personal growth so that they can be part of the main stream. The objective of this project is to continue with our Community development services even in this **Post Covid Era**.
